

## Bill to Make Noncreditable for Federal Retirement Any Member Service Performed By a Member of Congress Convicted of Certain Offenses

H.R.476 [110th]

Title: To amend title 5, United States Code, to make noncreditable for Federal retirement purposes any Member service performed by an individual who is convicted of any of certain offenses committed by that individual while serving as a Member of Congress, and for other purposes.
