

Bill to Provide an Exception to the 60-Day Limit on Medicare Reciprocal Billing Arrangements Between Two Physicians While One is Ordered to Active Duty as a Member of a Reserve Component of the Armed Forces

Title: To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide an exception to the 60-day limit on Medicare reciprocal billing arrangements between two physicians during the period in which one of the physicians is ordered to active duty as a member of a reserve component of the Armed Forces.
