

Bill to Establish a Congressional Commission to Investigate Response to Hurricane Katrina

H.R.3764 [109th]

Title: To establish a congressional commission to examine the Federal, State, and local response to the devastation wrought by Hurricane Katrina in the Gulf Region of the United States especially in the States of Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, and other areas impacted in the aftermath and make immediate corrective measures to improve such responses in the future.
